TSPP Tree House Spot Cover

1) Feed the cinch tie through the hole in the back of the tree house with the skinny end first.



2) Feed the skinny end of the cinch tie under the spotlight wires until you have room to cinch together.



3) Tighten the cinch tie with the fat end toward the back in order to get the angle of the tree house pointing in an upward direction for a good player's point of view, but do not tighten all the way.



4) Be sure the ball will clear the tree house when passing across the monorail track.

5) After positioning the tree house to the proper angle, and with ball clearance, tighten and cut the extra portion of the cinch tie and use the extra branch of leaves that have been provided to “top off” and hide the cinch tie from view. You should be able to tuck the branch in between the wires and/or tree house to get it to stay without gluing.
